**ELIGIBILITY/FLEET/CLASSES**

Open to all Keel, Centerboard and Multi-hull sailboats.

Fleet/Class racing will be available to those classes registering 4 or more boats. Classes not able to make a fleet will race in their appropriate Handicap Fleet; a PHRF fleet, for keel boats; a Portsmouth Fleet for Centerboard boats and a separate handicap for multihull boats. For Non S.A.I.L. PHRF members, ratings will be determined by the OA/PRO and are not subject to appeal. Classes may be started together but will be scored separately.

**RULES AND EQUIPMENT**

This regatta will be governed by the current 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), by this NOR and by the regatta sailing Instructions. Sailing instructions will be available during the registration check in. the Casper Boat Club is the Organizing Authority.

## **SCORING**

The Low Point Scoring System described in Appendix A of the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the sailing instructions, will be used.

## **TROPHIES**

Trophies will be awarded to the winning helmsman in each class. Classes with 5 or more boats will receive trophies for first, second, and third places.

## **FACILITIES**

- Free lake access – No county fees at perk entrance.
- Deep water boat ramp or 2.0 ton crane launch (7'6" wide).
- Free Slips for keel boats on a first come – first serve basis, based on paid registrations.
- On-site self-contained camping at the Casper Boat Club w/ bath and shower access.
- Full access to the CBC restaurant, lounge, showers, swim beach and separate boat beach.
- Fun-loving family atmosphere!

## **NEW BOATING LAW**

Wyoming Game and Fish has instituted an "Aquatic Invasive Species Program" and this program requires that all boaters purchase an Aquatic Invasive Species decal and may be subject to a watercraft inspection before launching. Basically motorized out of state watercraft will pay \$30 and non-motorized watercraft will pay \$15 for the decal. There are authorized agents at Alcova to purchase these decals.
