Location: Union Reservoir, Longmont, Colorado

The Sparkler is for Juniors. Juniors race with adults, but are scored separately

1. Schedule of Events:

Sunday, July 6, 2008

07:30 to 09:00 Registration and Continental breakfast at clubhouse

10:00 Skippers meeting at the clubhouse

11:25 Warning signal for first race, addl. races to immediately follow

ASAP after last race - trophy presentation

No race will be started after 17:30

2. Rules:

This Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008.

3. Eligibility and Entry:

The event is open to One Design, Multi-Hull and Portsmouth dinghies that register and pay the fees. Boats racing One Design shall comply with their One Design Class rules.

Portsmouth boats shall comply with all Portsmouth rules. Five boats will make a fleet.

5. Fees:

Regatta Entry Fees: \$20.00

Entry fee includes: Continental breakfast and trophies.

Entry fee does not include vehicle, park or boat passes, (available at the Club house or the park entry station) or T-shirts.

Regatta T-shirt (short-sleeved) \$15.00

6. Measurement:

Measurement shall be governed by the individual class associations.

7. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing instructions will be available at the registration.

8. Regatta Site:

The regatta site will be at Union Sailing Club on the Eastern Shore of Union Reservoir, Longmont, Colorado

9. Racing Area and Courses: Racing area and courses will be as shown on the Union Sailing Club 2008 Race Course Chart, available at registration.

10. Penalty System: Rule 44.2 Two Turn Penalty shall apply.

11. Scoring: The low point scoring system of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 will be used. All races sailed will be scored.

12. Trophies:

Fleets with five or less boats will be awarded first and second place trophies. Fleets with six or more boats will be awarded first, second and third place trophies.
