HORNBLOWER REGATTA 2007
Saturday & Sunday, May 19 - 20



Rules: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005 - 2008, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the Sailing Instructions, rules of the Colorado Parks Department and Cherry Creek State Park and any other applicable rules. Class rules will apply for those sailing in One Design fleets.

Eligibility: The regatta is open to all “centerboard” and “multi-hull” boats. All eligible boats may be entered by completing a registration and release form and paying the appropriate fees. Fleet status will be given to groups of five or more One Design boats; all other boats will be formed into one or more Portsmouth Handicap fleets. Boats must have Portsmouth ratings based on more than five data points to be eligible for a trophy.

Schedule of events: Registration will begin at 0900 outside the Marina office. Competitors meeting will begin at 1030 on Saturday. First warning flag will be at 1130 each day. No races will be started after 1600 on Sunday.

Refreshments and Dinner will be served after Saturday’s racing.

Registration Forms and Sailing instructions will be available at the registration/check in table Saturday morning and at the DSA website – www.denversailing.org.

Be sure to arrive and launch early to be sure to get on the water, lake capacity is limited and racers will not be afforded any special access rights.

Fees: Regatta registration –

\$ 45.00 for DSA Members / \$50.00 for Non-DSA - Includes one meal ticket and shirt.
Additional shirts and meal tickets will be available at registration

Races: Up to eight (8) races are scheduled. One race will make the regatta.

Regatta / Race Area: The Regatta site for registration and competitors meeting will be outside the Cherry Creek Marina office. The race area will be Cherry Creek Lake. Each race course will be described in the Sailing Instructions and posted with each fleet’s preparatory signal.

Scoring System: The regatta will be scored using the Low Point System in Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing, with this modification: DNS/OCS/DNC = Number of starters plus 1; DNF = Number of finishers plus one; DSQ = Number of registrants plus 2. Scoring will be based on all races completed; no throwouts will be allowed unless seven (7) or more races are completed, in which case a boat’s worst score will be discarded.
