The seminar will include discussions of the changes in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012* that affect race management.

Each participant will receive study materials in advance of the seminar. Registration after January 15th will include a \$10 late fee. The deadline for registration is February 11th 2012. Non-members who register for this seminar, will be given a Special Introductory Membership, which includes a US Sailing one year adult membership.
